

Layton AYSO, Region 239 The World's Biggest Soccer Club Application for Player Scholarship

Dear Applicant,

It is the goal of AYSO to provide world class youth soccer programs that enrich children's lives. We strive to make soccer fun and accessible to everyone and we do not want financial circumstances to be a barrier to play. If you would like to be considered for a scholarship, please read the following eligibility requirements and attached application instructions carefully. Please complete the attached application form and submit via email to region239rc@laytonayso.com no later than midnight on June 30th 2019.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Scholarships are rewarded to residents of Layton City. Proof of residency (current utility bill, housing lease, etc.) will be required upon submitting the application.
- Income eligibility will be determined by showing proof of qualification in one of the following:
 - Free or reduced school lunch programs
 - Aid for Families with Dependent Children Program
 - Food stamps, Family Employment Program (FEP) or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDIR)
 - Government subsidized housing
 - Other please provide written documentation as proof of other reasons a soccer scholarship should be awarded.
- Parents/Guardian are encouraged to participate as a volunteer (upon completing a volunteer background check) by refereeing, coaching or other capacity.
- Participants may forfeit eligibility requirements for future scholarships should they not have at least 75% attendance in practice/games.
- Scholarship will be awarded for cost of program only. It will *not* cover AYSO national fee of \$20
- Scholarships are not rewarded past above mentioned deadline.

Application Process:

- Complete the attached Scholarship Application Form (one per family).
- All information must be submitted at the time of application. An incomplete application will not be considered.
- Please allow up to 7-10 days business days for application review and approval/denia.
- Scholarships will be awarded as full or partial as scholarships funding allows.
- Applicants will be notified of the status of their request.
- Applicants who are approved for the scholarship must still enroll participants via the registration process. The registration must be completed and national registration fee must be paid at the time of registration.
- Applicants must complete a new application every year.

Confidentiality:

• The information provided by the application form is confidential and will only be used to determine eligibility for program.
